NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the RS Aero class (5, 7 and 9 Rigs) who are members of the RS Aero Class Association.

5 FEES

5.1 The entry fee will be £10 per boat including lunch

7 SCHEDULE

7.1 Registration will be from 1000 to 1045

7.4 There will be 4 races scheduled

7.5 The first warning signal will be at 1125 for RS Aero.

11 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be determined by the race committee, they will use a number of fixed marks in approximate positions as shown on the diagram at <http://www.readingsc.org.uk/racing.html> plus any number of temporary marks.

13 SCORING

13.2 1 race is required to constitute a series

13.3 (a) when fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

20 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

21 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £2 million per incident or the equivalent.

The Exoneration Penalty [and the Advisory Hearing and RYA Arbitration] of the RYA Rules Disputes Procedures will be available.
